Masjid Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah

The Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah Mosque is the state mosque of Selangor and the country's largest mosque, and the second largest in Southeast Asia by capacity. Its most distinguishing feature is its large blue and silver dome. On a clear day it can be seen from some vantage points in Kuala Lumpur.

Beyond its role as a place of worship, the mosque is also a symbol of Islamic heritage and a popular destination for visitors seeking to experience its serene atmosphere and architectural beauty.

Sultan Alam Shah Museum

The Sultan Alam Shah Museum is the main state museum of Selangor and one of the key cultural landmarks in Shah Alam. Officially opened in 1989, it plays an important role in preserving, documenting, and showcasing the rich history and heritage of the state.

The museum houses a diverse range of exhibits, including traditional Malay costumes, royal regalia, ancient weapons, archaeological findings, and historical documents. There are also galleries dedicated to Selangor's early settlements, tin mining industry, and the evolution of its royal institution, offering visitors a comprehensive understanding of the state's development over time.

Today, it serves not only as a place for learning but also as a cultural hub for exhibitions, educational programs, and heritage appreciation, attracting students, researchers, and tourists alike.



Gombak-Hulu Langat Geopark

A Geopark is also where several disciplines converge, including ecology, archaeology, geology, history, and culture. These disciplines are brought together and managed comprehensively and effectively so that their interdependence is greatly enhanced.



Batu Caves

Batu Caves is actually a series of limestone caves containing several Hindu temples of which the one dedicated to Lord Murugan is the largest. This is where the world-renowned Thaipusam Festival is celebrated annually, with over 1.5 million devotees and visitors, climbing the 272 steps to the temple.



Sekinchan Paddy Field

90 kilometres from Shah Alam is this fishing village best known for its paddy fields, with picturesque sights of an aqueduct, water fowls and vast trenches of paddy fields. Rice harvesting is done around the middle of the year and is an interesting way to discover more about Asia's most popular staple food crop.

Along the way, you will find a water path (aqueduct), a little bridge, birds, and of course the paddy. There are also factories which allow visits. The staff will brief you on the paddy plantation process, type of rice, and so on. You can also purchase the rice here which is not available in the market.

Bukit Melawati

Formerly a 16th-century Malacca Sultanate fort, Bukit Melawati has a lighthouse built in 1907 by the British. Bukit Melawati in Kuala Selangor, Selangor, is a historic hill that once served as a strategic fortress of the Selangor Sultanate in the 18th century, particularly during the Dutch-Selangor conflicts.

Combining history, nature, and coastal scenery, Bukit Melawati is a popular spot for sightseeing and a relaxing day trip.

Sky Mirror Kuala Selangor

Sky Mirror, located off the coast of Kuala Selangor in Selangor, is a unique natural attraction that appears only during specific low tide periods. Officially known as Sasaran Beach, this hidden sandbank creates a stunning mirror-like effect when a thin layer of water reflects the sky, giving visitors the illusion of walking on water.

The main highlight of Sky Mirror is its surreal photography experience. The reflective surface allows for creative photos with perfect reflections of people, clouds, and props, making it especially popular among photographers and tourists. The wide, open space and shallow water create ideal conditions for capturing symmetrical and visually striking images.

To visit Sky Mirror, travelers must take a short boat ride arranged by local operators from Kuala Selangor. Since the phenomenon depends on tidal conditions, trips are only available on selected dates each month. Visitors are encouraged to check schedules in advance and plan accordingly.

Amverton Cove Golf & Island Resort

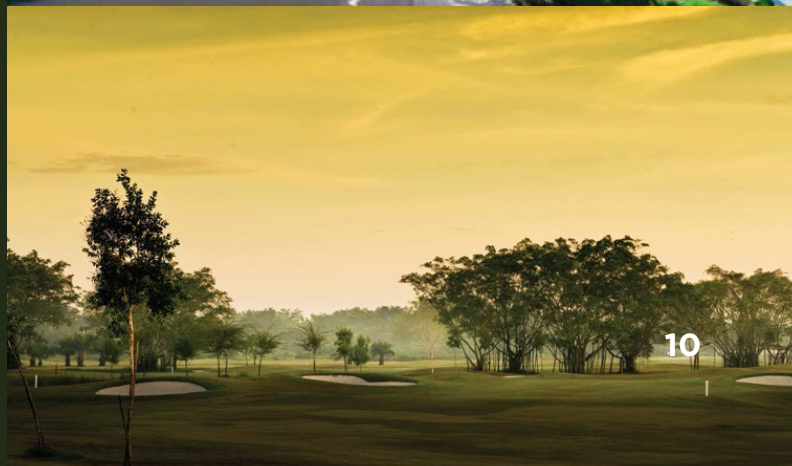

Sultan Abdul Aziz Royal Gallery



The Sultan Abdul Aziz Royal Gallery provides visitors with an insight into Selangor's cultural heritage and focuses on the legacy of the Selangor Royal family covering generations of tradition, artistry, and prestige. It emphasises the 39 year reign of Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz, the 8th Sultan and 11th King of Malaysia.



Masjid Jamek Cina Muslim Klang

Located in Bandar Botanik, Klang, the mosque sits on an area covering 2.98 acres and can accommodate 1,000 worshippers. It is the only mosque in Selangor with Chinese architectural features and also has library facilities, lecture rooms, management offices, rooms for the Imams, lounges, souvenir shops and a restaurant.

It highlights how Islamic traditions harmoniously integrate with Chinese aesthetics, creating a welcoming and visually striking space.

Today, the mosque attracts both worshippers and visitors who appreciate its architecture, peaceful atmosphere, and representation of Malaysia's multicultural identity.

Pulau Ketam

Pulau Ketam, located off the coast of Klang in Selangor, is a unique fishing village known for its traditional wooden houses built on stilts above muddy mangrove swamps.

Located in the centre of the city, it began to evolve into what it is today in the early 1900s, when a number of Indian-Muslim businesses and restaurants settled in the area and now has shops selling fabrics, fragrant spices and outstanding Indian cuisine.
